- The employment of support staff to support the delivery of the English and mathematics program;
- The provision of additional Speech Language support.
- The provision of resources to support curriculum delivery.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Teacher planning days – \$120,000
- Teacher formative moderation check-ins – \$65,000
- Speech language provision - \$18,000
- Additional HOC resourcing - \$50,000
- Resourcing additional support for priority areas - \$113 501
