

This fortnight several classes have been looking at the word empathy and what it means to them. Some incredible young year 5 men shared stories of empathy in their own lives on this week's podcast.





Tylus – "When I was at rugby training another player tackled me and I corked my thigh. All the players got around me and found me some ice. It made me feel awesome and I loved the empathy they showed".

Sam – "One time I hit my chin on a metal pole and it was a terrible cut. My best friend helped me and his family rushed me to hospital and looked after me. This made me feel so good inside".
